

Kerbside Waste Collection – Bin Assistance Application

Assistance may be provided where a resident is unable to place their own bins out for regular waste collection service and retrieve their bins after waste collection.

This service can only be provided for the regular collection of kerbside bins, as described in City of Prospect's Kerbside Waste and Recycling Management Policy (available online at <u>https://www.prospect.sa.gov.au/council/council-documents/policies-procedures</u>).

To request assistance, complete this form addressing each of the items listed below. You will also need to attach documentary evidence (a functional assessment) from a medical practitioner or other suitably qualified person¹ to support your application, confirming that assistance is required.

Once a Bin Assistance Application has been received, Council will review and forward the application to East Waste. East Waste will visit the property to complete a risk assessment before agreeing to provide this service.
