



FESTIVE STREETS EXPLOSION – FAQ Sheet

We're excited, bursting...almost EXPLODING with excitement to bring back fun community events this Festive Season! We want us to celebrate Christmas together, but not ALL together (thanks Aunt 'Rona!).

City of Prospect is helping you to throw one of ten street parties on Sunday 13 December from 6pm to 10pm and we will make sure your event is a cracker by providing some entertainment and festive cheer!

Question: How do I get involved?

Answer:

If you would like to host a street party in the City of Prospect, please see the application details on the webpage. If you would like to come as a food truck or children's entertainer, or if you have any questions about the event, please email admin@prospect.sa.gov.au.

Question: Who will organise the party for my street?

Answer:

You need to organise your own party for your street; including if there is a theme, outdoor activities, games or decorations. You need to invite your neighbours and remind them before the day to make sure they turn up! We will supply some music, temporary children's entertainment and some food trucks may visit – however this is not guaranteed to be sufficient for your whole evening. We suggest that you organise some other forms of hospitality and entertainment. We have made some recommendations in our draft letter which you will receive when you apply.

Question: How will the road closures work?

Answer:

City of Prospect will develop a Traffic Management Plan which allows us to close a section of the road and put in place detours for traffic. We will cover the costs to close the road and safely provided a space for you to host your party on the street from 6-10pm. The road

closures are likely to start from 2pm or 3pm in the afternoon depending on how busy your street is. This means you will be able to set up (tables, chairs, decorations, games etc) from at least 2 hours before the party.

Question: What will the music entertainment be?

Answer:

As the organiser of the street party, you can choose from some options of music including DJs, bands or choirs. You can even chose to bring your own band and we'll supply the equipment (limits apply).

Question: Can I choose the children's entertainment?

Answer:

We have a selection of children's entertainers who will be popping into your party at various times. There may be jugglers, magicians, or people on unicycles, but it will depend on your proximity to other street parties as to which entertainers will come to your party.

Question: How do I get my neighbours to come to the event?

Answer:

We will provide you with a letter template that you can customise for your party. We will then print enough copies for you street. You can collect them from Payinthe and put them in the letterboxes of all the neighbours in your street (or nearby streets).

Question: Can I invite my friends or family?

Answer:

Unfortunately as we are considering strict restrictions on hosting people in public places due to the pandemic, you must only invite neighbours from your street area and their immediate families. Friends from other areas in the City of Prospect are not permitted at your party.

Question: Will we be able to eat together on the street?

Answer:

Yes, you are able to eat and drink on the street outside your home. At this stage, you will not be able to share food or bring food for everyone to eat. However, you can bring your own food to eat on the street or take advantage of the food trucks that will pull up at the end of the street and sell food items.

Question: Do I need a liquor licence?

Answer:

No. You are welcome to bring you own beverages (alcoholic or non-alcoholic) to the street and consume. You are not permitted to sell beverages. We recommend that you use plastic cups or cans rather than glass.

Question: Can I have my party at a different time or a different day?

Answer:

No. We are only supporting street parties that are being held on Sunday 13 December from 6pm to 10pm. This year we are offering something new and will contribute to entertainment costs but for that reason we are restricting them to one date only.
